The RGV Partnership was established in 1944 to engage influencers, decision makers and policymakers to advance the prosperity of the Rio Grande Valley. In 2014, the Board of Directors launched the RGV Leadership program to engage and educate leaders on the importance of collaboration and engagement across our four-county region.

The RGV Leadership program will begin its 8th annual 9-month educational program that will promote collaboration and discussion on the region's most pressing challenges and opportunities.

Program & Objectives

RGV Leadership strives to fulfill the following objectives:

- Build long lasting relationships with leaders from across the RGV
- Engage class members with elected officials and stakeholders in a leadership position
- Have a deeper understanding & appreciation of the RGV's challenges and opportunities
- Engage in a group project – with a formal presentation at the end of the program

Time Commitment

Time commitment is very important...timely attendance is required. The program begins with an orientation retreat in South Padre Island that will require a one (1) overnight stay; meals and hotel included in the tuition fee.

(Retreat is scheduled to take place on Friday, September 16th and Saturday, September 17th)

After the retreat, you will be required to attend full day sessions once a month, **which will be on the fourth Friday of each month. Friday sessions will take place between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.**

Tuition

RGV Leadership is offered to participants at \$1,000 in tuition. The tuition includes all program materials, class shirts, snacks, meals, overnight accommodations during the retreat and some transportation. You have the option to pay in full by the first meeting or it can be in paid in three installments.

APPLICANT AGREEMENT

Minimum of two letters of recommendation must be submitted. One of those letters must be submitted by your current employer.

Rio Grande Valley Leadership is a 9-month program that includes a retreat in South Padre Island that takes place on Friday, September 16th and Saturday, September 17th, 2021. Friday night hotel accommodations are included in your tuition. Attendance at the initial retreat is mandatory for all class participants.

Following the retreat, an 8-month program will be in place that will consist of full-day sessions on the 4th Friday of each month. The sessions will be hosted across our four-county region. Each session will include group discussions and an opportunity to work on an assigned team project.

Missing the initial retreat or more than 2 sessions during the program will automatically terminate your enrollment. Three late arrivals or early departures, or combination of the two, will be cause for automatic dismissal.

Personal electronic devices must be turned off during meetings.
